# Costa Diadema

Every detail of the Costa Diadema was considered. Every facet. Every fitting. She's a spacious, royal vessel who generously shares her beauty as she moves about her Mediterranean domain.

# Costa Favolosa

If cruise ships were a standard feature in fairytales, the Costa Favolosa would appear regularly. Her tiered balconies and sparkling interiors evoke princess gowns and glittering tiaras.

### Costa Fascinosa

Step onto Costa Fascinosa, a ship that takes her theme from cinema's brightest talent. Experience the glamour of stepping onto a movie set. You'll find yourself surrounded by the faces of Hollywood's finest, including Marilyn Monroe, David Lynch, and Italian director Luchino Visconti.

### Costa Pacifica

Hold a shell to your ear and you'll hear the music of the ocean (and the influence for the Costa Pacifica). Italian great Mauro Pagani composed pieces specifically for this ship. There's a recording studio on board for passengers, too.

# Costa Luminosa

The sun. The moon. Both celestial bodies cast light on the ocean, and the theme of the Costa Luminosa reflects it. Huge chandeliers, light displays, Murano glass lampshades, and iridescent fabrics make the interior of the ship shimmer.

# Costa Serena

Sail on a floating pantheon. Costa Serena celebrates Greek mythology. Inside the ship's atrium, Zeus and the other gods stand aloft, gazing down on people below.

# Costa Magica

The Costa Magica draws its inspiration from cities on Italy's coast. Italian art and artists are honored everywhere on the ship. (Even the decks are named for artists.)

#### Costa Fortuna

The Costa Fortuna is dedicated to the early days of transatlantic travel. Replicas of several Costa ships sit inside the soaring entrance hall, demonstrating the fleet's enduring comfort and elegance.

## Costa Deliziosa

The Costa Deliziosa recalls art and architecture. A modern sculpture sits in the atrium. Architect Joseph Farcus designed the space with wood, a material that complements the warm light reflecting off Pomodoro's bronze sphere.

# Costa Atlantica

The Costa Atlantica captures the earthy sensuality of Fellini's award-winning "La Dolce Vita." Romantic colors, plush fabrics, and warm light create the feeling that the famed director could appear at any moment.

## Costa Victoria

The Costa Victoria's huge planetarium contains a steel sculpture that points skyward. Throughout the ship, glass mosaics soften its modernist edge. The biggest mosaic, a playful piece by Emilio Tadini, sits above one of the ship's bars.
